

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LAKE PLACE SWIMMING POOL

The enjoyment of the pool and surrounding Facilities is dependent on a high standard of sanitation and conduct as required by these rules. The Association is not responsible for any accidents resulting from the misuse of the pool or surrounding facilities.

The pool will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. The season will begin on or about Memorial Day and extend to on or about Labor Day.

Pool access will be with the key provided to the unit owner/tenant and no one without their key is to be admitted except the guest of Unit Owner/tenant.

Rules 2 through 5 were adopted in conformity of the State Department of Health.

- 1.) The pool is for exclusive use of resident unit owners, tenants and their immediate families or invited guests. Invited guests will not exceed four per unit and must be accompanied by the owner or resident. Note that each child counts as one guest. The Board reserves the right to establish further guest regulations to assure equitable use of the facility by all residents.
- 2.) All persons known or suspected of being afflicted with communicable diseases, or with a cold, cough or inflamed throat, or any skin disease, or wearing bandages, shall be excluded from the pool.
- 3.) All persons shall shower before entering the pool. There are showers located in the pool restrooms.
- 4.) Those having used oil or other ointment must shower again before entering the pool.
- 5.) Expectorating or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
- 6.) Diving is not permitted.
- 7.) Running and boisterous or rough play is prohibited. Please monitor your children's voice level to insure a restful and peaceful experience for others.
- 8.) Nothing shall be taken inside the pool that may tend to pollute the water or injure the bathers. This includes tennis balls, diapers, etc. "Swimmies" are required for children not toilet trained.
- 9.) All pets are prohibited from the pool area.
- 10.) The use of glassware or other breakable containers is prohibited from the pool or pool area. No food or alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the pool area.
- 11.) Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- 12.) The Association will provide lawn chairs for use by the residents in the pool area. These chairs are not to be removed from the pool area.
- 13.) All personal belongings, e.g., personal beach chairs, towels, etc., must be removed from the pool area daily. The Association is not responsible for personal property.
- 14.) The gates to the pool area must be closed and locked at all times.
- 15.) No Smoking will be allowed in the pool area at any time. Smoking is only allowed outside of the clubhouse, where there is a receptacle for disposal of ash and cigarettes.
